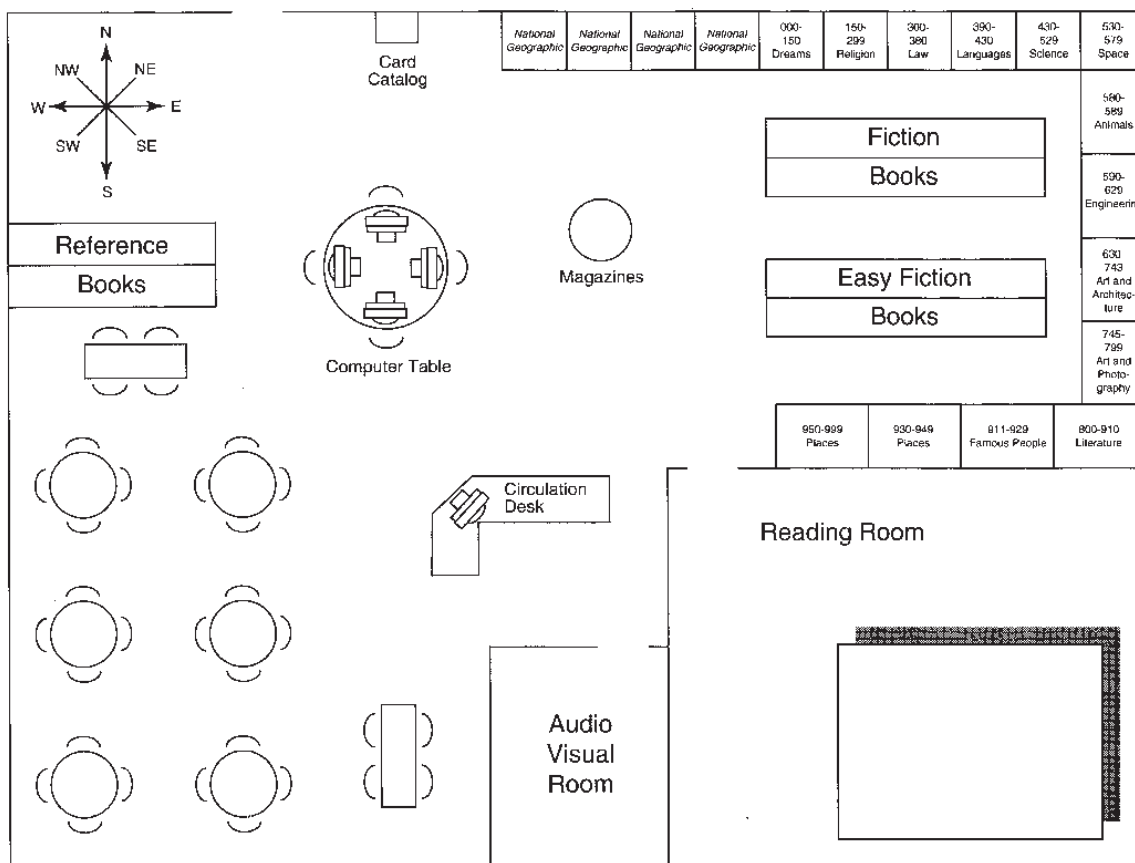


## MAKING A MAP

**Directions:** You must find the answer to the clues in the library (even if you already know the answer) and record the answer along with the source.

**Clue 1**

- This is an ancient Chinese mathematical tool.
- It is used to make calculations.
- It is made of beads strung on a wire inside a frame.

**Clue 2**

- This geographical location which was opened in 1914 connects the Caribbean Sea with the Pacific Ocean.
- It is 50 miles long and at the deepest point is 269 feet deep.
- Before this was built the only water route from the Pacific Ocean to the Atlantic Ocean was around the tip of South America.

**Clue 3**

- This man was a French painter who lived from 1840 to 1926.
- He was the first painter to be called an impressionist because of a painting he created called “Impression—Sunrise.”
- Several of his paintings showed the effect of light on a subject. Later in his life he focused on painting garden scenes and water lilies.

**Clue 4**

- This alphabet was invented before the Roman alphabet.
- Some letters from this alphabet are also in the Cyrillic alphabet.
- The first two letters of this alphabet are the origin of the actual word “alphabet.”

**Clue 5**

- I am so small that you cannot see me without a microscope.
- I am all around you.
- There are certain types of me—called bacteria and viruses—that make people feel bad.

**Clue 6**

- Although there are thousands of this type of organization in the world, there are nine main groups to which people belong.
- One of the main reasons that the Pilgrims came to America was for the freedom to belong to the group in this category that they chose.
- Some countries fight wars because of the different beliefs people have about this topic.

**Clue 7**

- This is a piece of literature that was written for children in 1865.
- Some of the characters in this book are the Ugly Duchess, the Mock Turtle, and the Mad Hatter.
- Lewis Carroll was the author of this book.
