Image Assistant Rubric

Evaluates a student's observation and interpretation skills and use of evidence, questioning, and conclusions.

Identify Details	Identifies multiple relevant visual details, including both obvious and subtle features, accurately describing what is visible.	Identifies several obvious visual details but overlooks important or less noticeable features.	Identifies few details or provides vague or inaccurate observations.
Generate Questions	Generates thoughtful questions that deepen understanding of the image and encourage further investigation.	Generates relevant but fairly basic questions about the image.	Generates few, unclear, or unrelated questions.
Make Predictions	Makes logical predictions or hypotheses that are well supported by specific visual evidence.	Makes a reasonable prediction with limited supporting evidence.	Makes an unsupported, vague, or missing prediction.
Interpret Meaning	Explains the meaning, message, or significance of the image using multiple visual details to support the interpretation.	Provides a general interpretation with limited explanation or supporting details.	Describes the image without interpreting its meaning.
Make Inferences	Makes well-supported inferences by combining visual evidence with relevant background knowledge or reasoning.	Makes a reasonable inference with partial support from the image.	Has difficulty making an inference or provides one with little supporting evidence.
Draw Evidence-Based Conclusions	Draws a clear conclusion that synthesizes observations, interpretations, and inferences, supporting it with specific evidence from the image.	Draws a reasonable conclusion with some supporting evidence.	Draws a vague, unsupported, or incomplete conclusion.



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
